§ 1 Object of the Agreement

The object of this Agreement is the storage and making publicly accessible of the following work:

work's title and year of publication

on the server of GenderOpen – A Gender Studies Repository.

§ 2 Granting of Rights to the Operators of the *GenderOpen* Repository

1. I grant the operators of the *GenderOpen* repository the non-exclusive right, free of charge and without territorial or time restrictions, to hold the above-named work and its associated metadata including the abstract on the servers of *GenderOpen* – A Gender Studies Repository, to duplicate it, to permanently store it electronically, to distribute it, and to make it publicly accessible on the Internet without charge. This right applies to all known present, and possible future, types of use.
2. I grant the operators of the *GenderOpen* repository the right to make the document available to other libraries, archives, and aggregators for the purposes of long-term archiving and/or public access. This includes, for example, the digital archives of the German National Library DNB and other relevant subject-based or regional repositories.
3. I agree that the metadata, including the abstract, will be published under the license Creative Commons Zero (CC0; see <https://creativecommons.org/publicdomain/zero/1.0/>).
4. I permit the operators of the *GenderOpen* repository to provide users upon request with a copy of the work or of parts of the work in print form (print on demand) or electronically for their private or other personal use (as defined in section 53 of the German Copyright Law, UrhG). The operators of the *GenderOpen* repository may commission third parties to provide this service.
5. For the purposes of archiving, and as long as the integrity of the content is not affected, I agree for copies to be made and the document to be converted into other electronic or physical formats.
